THE DAY AT A GLANCE

times after roll-out are estimates

- 8:30 AM** ● **Check-In Opens — Basecamp Brewing**
Waivers signed. Coffee & donuts.
- 9:05 AM** ○ **Driver's Briefing**
Route, radio protocol, convoy spacing. ~15 minutes.
- 9:20 AM** ● **Vehicle Roll Out**
One convoy, two groups.
- 9:35 AM** ○ **Tripoli Road** **DIRT**
11 mi through the Waterville Valley backcountry.
- 10:20 AM** ○ **Sandwich Notch Road** **DIRT**
9 mi of classic notch road into the backroads to Tamworth.
- 11:45 AM** ● **Regroup — Saco Ranger Station** **STOP**
Restrooms, head count, stretch. ~15 minutes.
- 12:00 PM** ○ **Bear Notch Road** **SCENIC**
Paved climb over to Bartlett, then Route 302 west through Crawford Notch.
- 1:35 PM** ● **Lunch — Dolly Copp Picnic Pavilion** **1 HR**
Catered lunch at the 1936 CCC stone pavilion. Eat, regroup, restrooms.
- 2:30 PM** ○ **Depart for Mt. Washington Auto Road**
Short hop south on Route 16 to the toll house.
- 2:45 PM** ● **Climb Mt. Washington** **SUMMIT**
7.6 miles to the top of the Northeast. Staggered ascent, summit photos.
- 4:30 PM** ○ **Last Car Off the Mountain**
Sweep confirms everyone is down off the summit.
- 5:00 PM** ○ **Jefferson Notch** **DIRT**
One last dirt run on the drive home — the highest public road in New Hampshire.

ROUTE HIGHLIGHTS

TRIPOLI & SANDWICH NOTCH

MORNING · DIRT

Twenty miles of classic White Mountain notch roads to start the day — single-file through the trees, windows down.

MT. WASHINGTON SUMMIT

AFTERNOON · AUTO ROAD

7.6 miles and 4,600 vertical feet to the 6,288' summit — the highest peak in the Northeast and the day's climax.

JEFFERSON NOTCH

DRIVE HOME · DIRT

The highest public through-road in New Hampshire — the last dirt of the day, run on the way back to Lincoln.

FRANCONIA NOTCH

EVENING · PAVED

A scenic cruise south on Route 3 through the notch — the cool-down lap back into Lincoln.

BEFORE YOU GO

- › **Full tank of fuel.** Top off in Lincoln before roll-out — no fuel stops on route.
- › **Sunscreen & water.** Long day, lots of open sky and dust.
- › **GPX loaded.** Route file on your device as a backup to the convoy.
- › **Summit layers.** The top of Mt. Washington is cold and windy even in June.
- › **Camera.** Drone & photo crew embedded — but you'll want your own shots too.
